Cookie Policy

§ 1. What are cookies?

1. The website automationnex.io (hereinafter: "Service") uses cookies.

2. Cookies are small text files that are saved and stored on your end device (computer,

tablet, smartphone) when you visit various websites on the internet.

3. Cookies typically contain the name of the website they originate from, their lifespan, and

a unique number used to identify the browser from which the connection to the site is

made.

§ 2. For what purpose do we use cookies?

Cookies on our Service are used for:

1. Ensuring proper functioning of the Service (necessary cookies): These are crucial for

the website's operation, enabling navigation and use of basic functions, such as access to

secure areas. Without these files, the Service cannot function properly.

2. Analytical and statistical purposes (analytical cookies): They help us understand how

Users use the Service. We collect anonymous statistical data that allows us to analyze

website traffic, identify popular content, and optimize the structure and content of the

Service to better meet Users' needs.

3. Functional purposes (functional cookies): They allow the Service to "remember" settings

selected by the User and personalize the interface, e.g., regarding selected language, font

size, website appearance, etc.

4. Marketing purposes (marketing cookies): They may be used for marketing and

remarketing activities, i.e., to display personalized advertisements on other websites to

Users who have previously visited our Service.

§ 3. Types of cookies used

Within the Service, two main types of cookies are used:

- Session cookies: Temporary files that are stored on the User's end device until logout, leaving the website, or closing the software (web browser).
- Persistent cookies: Stored on the User's end device for a time specified in the cookie parameters or until they are deleted by the User.

§ 4. Cookie management

- 1. During the first visit to the Service, information about the use of cookies is displayed. The User has the ability to manage their consent for individual categories of cookies (except for necessary cookies).
- 2. Most web browsers allow cookie storage on the end device by default. The User can change cookie settings in their browser at any time. They can, among other things, block automatic cookie handling or be informed about each placement of cookies on the device.
- 3. Detailed information about the possibilities and methods of handling cookies is available in the software settings (web browser).
- 4. Restricting the use of cookies may affect some functionalities available on the Service's websites.

§ 5. Final provisions

- 1. The Administrator reserves the right to make changes to this Cookie Policy.
- 2. In matters not regulated by this Cookie Policy, the provisions of the Service's Privacy Policy and Polish law shall apply accordingly.
